Call to Order: 9:55 a.m.

Discussion:

1. The purpose of the meeting was to coordinate last minute details for the following day's 5K Run/Walk fundraiser.
2. Kelly Gray shared that t-shirts will not be ready until the morning of the event.
3. During the meeting, gift bags for participants were stuffed to include shower cards, cancer awareness and prevention materials, "save the date" cards, and discount coupons for Dick's Sporting Goods.
4. Kelly picked up some pink water bottles and umbrellas to be used as give-aways during the event. The water bottles will go to the team that raised the largest amount in donations. The umbrellas will be gifts to survivors who are participating.
5. Survivors will be invited to wear pink ribbon stickers during the event to identify themselves.
6. Panera will prove a gift certificate to the team that raised the largest amount in donations.
7. Kelly asked the group for permission to purchase two pink folding chairs to give away: one to the person who raised the most in donations, the other to be used as a raffle item during the event. The group voted unanimously in favor.
8. A "spirit stick" will be presented to the team who displays the most passion. The stick will be forwarded each year and presented as an informal award to boost morale and increase enthusiasm.
9. Nice trophies were donated by Emerald Engraving in Ashland and will be presented to 1st and 2nd place finishing men and women in the 5K.
10. Kelly has arranged for golf carts to be used by volunteers during the event.
11. Volunteers will be utilized at each crosswalk on campus and at a gravel transition in the woods. They will help with traffic control and to maintain the safety of participants. Kelly provided maps of the course that will be available during the event.
12. Early volunteers will mark the course and place signage.
13. A volunteer will host a table featuring self-exam information with models for participants to "practice" with.
14. Penny Snyder will lead a Girl Scout troop to hand out water bottles at the "turn around" in the course.

15. Volunteers will help at the end of the race to time runners and track their individual race times.
16. The Mansfield News Journal will be cover the event.

Kelly asked all in attendance to consider attending State Convention on October 20 and 21, 2007. The SNA has some funds available to defer costs of those who wish to attend overnight or for one day only. All responses are due by October 17, 2007 so Kelly can book or cancel rooms as needed.
