~ Prior to Graduation, all students entering after Summer 2008, must receive credit for MTH 103 - Introduction to Algebra, or any math course above MTH 103, or a Compass Algebra score of above 30, or an ACT score above 20. **Does not apply to students completing only the Peace Officer Academy.**
