*** Mandatory Math Placement - All incoming students will be required to take the COMPASS placement test and based on their compass scores, students will be placed in appropriate mathematics courses. Successful completion (C- or better) of any math course is required in order to advance to the next higher level math course.

~ Prior to Graduation, all students entering after Summer 2008, must receive credit for MTH 103 - Introduction to Algebra, or any math course above MTH 103, or a Compass Algebra score of above 30, or an ACT score above 20.

The college strongly recommends that students in the Practical Nursing program be covered by hospitalization insurance, which can be purchased either through a private carrier or through the college-sponsored insurance program. IMPORTANT ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY INFORMATION: Students who plan to articulate into the Associate Degree Nursing Program may wish to substitute the Human Anatomy and Physiology courses BIO 145, BIO 146, BIO 147, for the Basic Anatomy and Physiology courses. BIO 147 must be completed prior to entrance into PNR 153.

The **PRACTICAL NURSING** program is four quarters and contains a sequence of clinical classes that begins in the fall and spring quarters each year. Entrance into the clinical sequence is limited to students who have successfully completed the entrance requirements. Copies of the entrance requirements are available from the Admissions Office. An acceptable Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation (BCI&I) report/FBI background check and drug screening are required in order to enter the clinical sequence. Students may begin non-PNR courses any quarter. A minimum grade of C- is required in BIO 101, BIO 121, BIO 122, BIO 155* and all PNR classes in order to meet prerequisite requirements. * **Applies only if taken after Winter, 1999**
