Intervention Description	In Spring 2006, NC State administered for the first time the Community College Survey of Student Engagement, and repeated it again in Spring 2008 (results pending). Note that in the 2006 survey comparisons are made throughout against all two-year colleges taking the survey (447) and similar size colleges taking the survey (247). NC State intends to benchmark responses from the 2008 survey against the 2006 survey to gauge trends. It has added a staffer skilled in database management to its Institutional Research Department that should allow time for such analysis. It is hoped that survey answers, especially when disaggregated, may shed light on existing strategies or suggest new strategies.

## Evaluation

Brief description of Evaluation	The Core Team originally noted that developmental students reporting positive advising experiences on CCSSE surveys would increase by 10% from the 2006 to 2008 surveys. Part of this could be taken from the special focus questions for the AtD Consortium. In addition, the Data Team intends to weave in relevant questions from the entire survey group or subgroup into the summer evaluation. We are not saying CCSSE replaces focus groups, but it can provide some insight especially when taking observations from certain groups (such as developmental students who identify themselves). A sample of observations from the 2006 survey is attached.
