This means that you will complete your sophomore year of high school and then transition into the program for fall semester full time at North Central State College. The degree will be an associate of science with a chosen pathway in bioscience, health, or science education. This degree will prepare you for transition to a four-year university to obtain a higher level degree. All courses will be Ohio Transfer Module (OTM) or Transfer Assurance Guide (TAG) for transfer credit to any public institution in Ohio.

Please work with your high school advisor or contact North Central State College's Health Science Center at 419-755-4805 to begin the process and set your future path to a four-year degree.

How do I apply to the Health program?

The following items must be completed and be part of your records at North Central State College before acceptance to the SCI-MED Academy can be determined. **All required materials must be submitted to the selection committee by June 23, 2018,** in order to be considered for the Fall Semester, 2018, group. 1. Application to the college.

The CCP application to North Central State College must be completed by May 1, 2018. The enrollment process can be completed in the Admissions Office in Kee Hall, or online at http://www.ncstatecollege.edu/apply. A letter of acceptance from the college will be sent to you once this step is completed. Please note that the enrollment process to the college is not complete until you have completed the items below.

Students who desire acceptance into the SCI-MED Academy must declare a major in Associate of Science SCI-MED Academy. This status neither implies nor guarantees eventual acceptance to the SCI-MED Academy.

2. Official copy of high school transcript.

An official copy of your high school transcript must be submitted to the Office of Admissions in Kee Hall. High school sophomore's going into their junior year must have their transcript on file with the college by June 23, 2018 (this would include all work through your sophomore year of high school).

3. ACCUPLACER Assessment or ACT Test Scores.

You must take the ACCUPLACER Next Generation Assessment Test or ACT prior to the June 23, 2018 deadline. Contact the Student Success Center in Kee Hall (419-755-4764), or visit http://www.ncstatecollege.edu/ssc for more information. Your high school counselor will be able to assist you. The ACCUPLACER Next Generation or ACT must be completed and submitted to the Student Records Office in Kee Hall prior to June 23, 2018.

Qualifying ACCUPLACER/ACT score.

You must complete the following:

• Complete the ACCUPLACER Next Generation Assessment test with a Reading score (RD) of 263 or higher or Complete the ACT with a Reading score of 21 or higher.

SCI-MED ACADEMY PROCESS

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- Complete the ACCUPLACER Next Generation Assessment test with a Writeplacer score of 5 or higher or complete the ACT with an English Writing score of 18 or higher or e-Write with a score of 8 or higher.
- Complete the ACCUPLACER Next Generation Assessment test with a College Level Math Score of 263 or higher for Arithmetic and 250 or higher for Advanced Algebra or Complete the ACT test with a Math score of 22 or higher.

4. Chemistry

You must have completed one unit of high school chemistry with a grade of C- or above by end of sophomore year of high school. For temporary acceptance following the sophomore year of high school, taking the summer semester CHEM 1010 Introduction to Chemistry course at North Central State College passing with a C- or better will complete your application.

5. Completion of Application Form

Student must complete and submit the application form.

6. Grade Point Average (GPA)

A 2.8 or higher on a scale of 0-4 cumulative high school grade point average (GPA) is required. 12 semester credit hours of North Central State College or transfer credit coursework with a minimum grade of "C" or better for each course with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 will also be accepted.

7. Letters of Recommendation

Letter of recommendation by high school science instructor. Letter of recommendation by high school guidance counselor.

8. Signature Parent Awareness Form

Parent must complete and sign the Parent Awareness Form.
